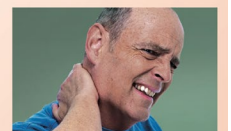

Any individuals interested in learning more about rat lungworm disease and how to prevent its spread are encouraged to attend, including farmers and home gardeners.

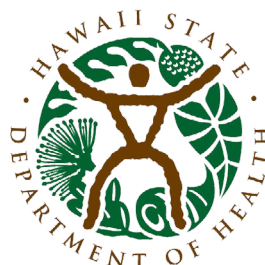
